

## Merchant Marine Credential (MMC) Application Package Checklist

This checklist is intended to assist the applicant in applying for a renewal of a USCG Merchant Marine Credential. The completed application package must be delivered to one of 17 USCG Regional Exam Centers (REC) around the nation. - \_\_\_ TWIC (Transportation Workers Identification Credential)  
All applicants must hold a valid TWIC prior to applying for any MMC. To locate a TWIC enrollment center visit [twicinformation.tsa.dhs.gov/twicinfo/schedule.jsp](http://twicinformation.tsa.dhs.gov/twicinfo/schedule.jsp)

### Complete each of the following USCG forms as directed

- \_\_\_ Application for License (form CG-719B) expires 03/04, valid until further notice
- \_\_\_ Small Vessel Sea Service (form CG-719S) expires 03/04, valid until further notice  
Use one form for each vessel to document your sea service experience in calendar days.  
The total number of days required will depend on the license you are applying for.
- \_\_\_ DOT/USCG Periodic Drug Test (form CG-719P) expires 03/04, valid until further notice
- \_\_\_ Medical Evaluation Report (form CG-719K) expires 6/30/2012

### Renewal Options

1. If you have 360 days of sea service experience within the term of your license you may renew your license without examination.
  - a. If you have a radar observer endorsement you must complete a radar renewal course to maintain the endorsement.
  - b. If you hold an STCW 95 endorsement you must have 360 days of sea service experience on oceans within the term of your license or you will be required to complete a BST renewal course to maintain the endorsement.
2. If you do not have 360 days of sea service experience within the term of your license you may still renew your license by:
  - a. Completing an approved renewal course.
  - b. Completing an open book exam.
    - i. My suggestion is to request the open book exam. The REC will mail the exam to you and give you 90 days to complete the exam using any and all resources available to you. Give me a call if you have trouble with the exam and I will be happy to assist you.
